"Stunt Man" (1970 - 1980)

Director Richard Rush

Peter O'Toole (starring role – movie director)

He achieved international recognition playing <u>T. E. Lawrence</u> in <u>Lawrence of Arabia</u> (1962) for which he received his first nomination for the <u>Academy Award for Best Actor</u>. He was nominated for this award another seven times – for <u>Becket</u> (1964), <u>The Lion in Winter</u> (1968), <u>Goodbye, Mr. Chips</u> (1969), <u>The Ruling Class</u> (1972), <u>The Stunt Man</u> (1980), <u>My Favorite Year</u> (1982), and <u>Venus</u> (2006) – and holds the record for the most Academy Award nominations for acting without a win.

Barbara Hershey (romantic interest)

Steve Railsback (stunt man)

He is best known for his performances in the films <u>The Stunt Man^[2]</u> and his portrayal of <u>Charles Manson</u> in the television miniseries <u>Helter Skelter</u>.

Letters from a Killer (1997 – 1998)

Patrick Swayze

Letters from a Killer was originally supposed to be finished earlier than its release, but filming was halted for two months due to Patrick Swayze suffering serious injuries when he fell off his horse in May 1997 and hit a tree. He ended up with both legs broken and four tendons in his shoulder immediately became detached. Although it was eventually released, Swayze was reported to have trouble resuming his career.

During his career, Swayze received three <u>Golden Globe Award</u> nominations, for <u>Dirty Dancing</u> (1987), <u>Ghost</u> (1990), and <u>To Wong Foo, Thanks for Everything, Julie Newmar</u> (1995). He wrote and recorded the popular song "<u>She's Like the Wind</u>" and was posthumously awarded the Rolex Dance Award in 2009.

Swayze suffered an early death in 2009 from cancer. He was 57 years old.
